Construction begins on Fortis's Financial District tower 1 Seaport

The bit of shoreline hugging the East River between the Lower East Side and the Financial District will soon look *very* different, with a number of new towers (including Extell's <u>Lower East Side skyscraper</u>) in various stages of progress. Construction has already begun on one of those, Fortis's 1 Seaport, which will

rise 670 feet and <u>have just 80 apartments</u>. YIMBY <u>reports</u> that foundation work on the skyscraper is underway, and shared a photo from Pizzarotti-IBC, which is working as the general contractor on the building. Nothing too exciting yet, but <u>sales launched</u> earlier this year, so the team behind it is surely eager to get this building up quickly.
